

WHAT TO PACK

- One windproof jacket.
- Two sweaters.
- One pair of warm gloves from June to August.
- One tracking suite.
- Two long sleeve shirts & two pairs of long pants.
- Two short sleeve shirts & two pairs of long pants.
- Two short sleeve shirts & two pairs of shorts.
- Four pairs of socks.
- One pair of good & comfortable walking shoe's for hunting in (Not new shoes and make sure not to use tennis shoes for hunting - only to relax in).
- One pair of comfortable shoes to relax in.
- Two caps or good hats for wearing in the sun.
- Good sunscreen & sunglasses.
- Insect repellent & malaria tablets (From October to November)
- Toiletries.
- Personal medication should you have any medical condition.
- One small bag to carry bullets, camera, video camera & snacks, etc. In, left on the vehicle while hunting.
- Rifle with ammunition, ammunition pouch/belt & cleaning kit for rifle.
- Soft rifle bags for each rifle to put rifles in when traveling by charter plane.
- Taxidermy tags of your desired taxidermy, where trophies will be sent to after the hunt.
- Video camera with extra batteries, 12 volt charger, extra video tapes. Camera with lots of film and extra batteries.
- Binoculars & a good flashlight with extra batteries.
- Passport with flight tickets.
- CITES Permit for Leopard, Rhino, Elephant, Hippo, Lion if applicable.

This is a general packing list that you can use as guideline. Please try and keep all bags as small as possible to make traveling by charter easier. There will be daily laundry services so please ensure to keep the luggage to as little as possible.
